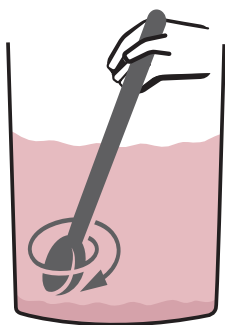

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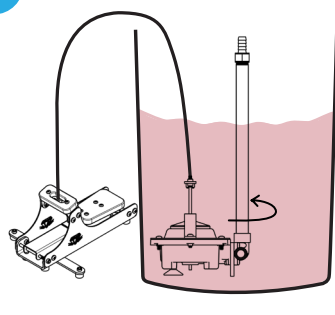

Glazing



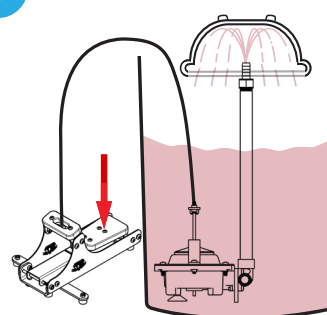
Stir sediment from bottom of bucket so the suction cups can attach firmly to a smooth surface.

Place the foot pedal on a flat surface and the pump in a glaze bucket. Move the pump around until you feel the suction cups attach securely.

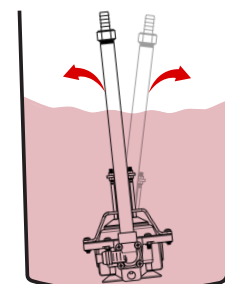

Place your piece over the fountain pipe then press down on the footboard to glaze your piece.

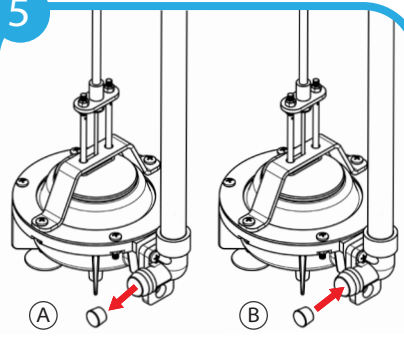

Cleanup



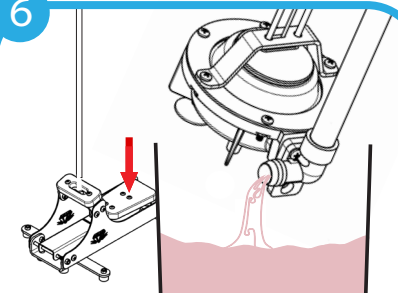
Remove pump from bottom of bucket by gently rocking it back and forth to release the suction cups.

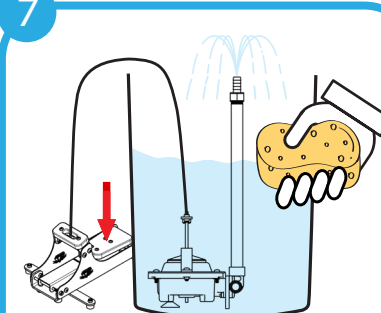
Removing plug at base of pipe (A).
Putting plug back in pump (B).

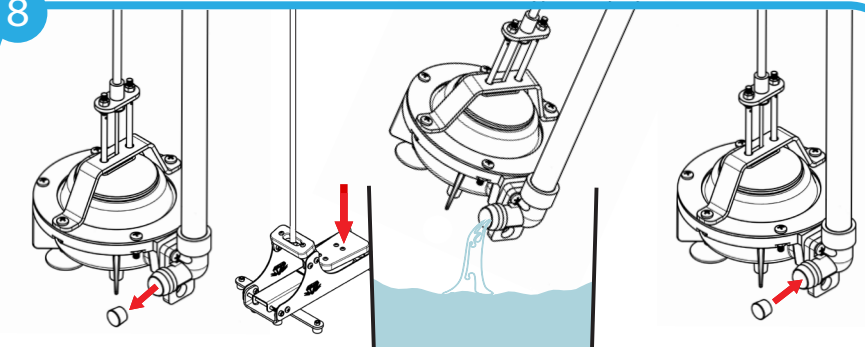
Remove the plug (see fig. 5A) and tilt pump towards plug opening to drain glaze from pipe and reservoir. Press down on the footboard several times to thoroughly empty the pipe and reservoir. Put plug back in pump (see fig. 5B)

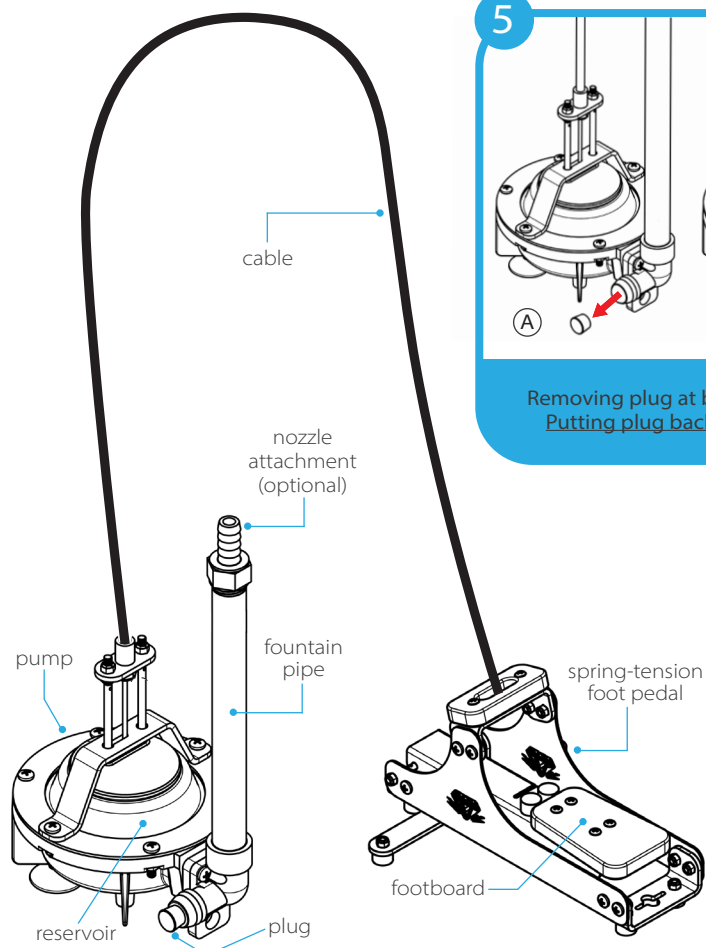


Place pump in a bucket of water and use a sponge to remove excess glaze. Use footboard to cycle water 5 to 10 times to flush remaining glaze.

Remove plug at base of pipe (left) and tilt pump towards plug opening to drain water from pipe and reservoir. Press down on the footboard several times to thoroughly empty the pipe and reservoir. Put plug back in pump (right).
